NOTICE is hereby given that the County Council of the County of Southampton, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by sub-section (3) of Section 29 of the National Parks and Access to the Countryside Act, 1949, have determined to modify the particulars contained in the Draft Map and Statement prepared under Section 27 of the above mentioned Act in relation to the Rights of Way within the area of the Havant and Waterloo Urban District in the said County by

68	do.	From the Urban District boundary, southwards between Twostone Bottom and Blackbush Hanger to its junction with Emsworth Common Road.
80 (part)	do.	Section of path at eastern end of New Cut.
90	do.	From its junction with Path No. 89 north-west of St. Mary's Church, south-eastwards to its junction with Church Road.
92 (part)	do.	From its junction with Path No. 89 at Higworth Farm southwards to its junction with the western end of Path No. 93.
