STREET URBAN DISTRICT COUNCIL.

*The Urban District Council of Street (Green
Lane Avenue Footpath) Diversion Order, 1955.*

NOTICE is hereby given that the above Order was made on the 24th day of January, 1955, and is about to be submitted to the Minister of Housing and Local Government for confirmation.

The effect of the Order will be to divert the public right of way running from Green Lane Avenue southwards to the footpath from Overleigh to Brooks Road, to a new line almost parallel with the existing route and joining the same footpath about 48 feet west of the present junction.

A certified copy of the Order and of the map contained in the Order has been deposited at the Council Offices, Leigh Road, Street, and will be open for inspection free of charge between the hours of 9 a.m. and 5 p.m. from Mondays to Fridays and 9 a.m. and 12 noon on Saturdays.

Any objection or representation with reference to the Order may be sent in writing to the Secretary, Ministry of Housing and Local Government, Whitehall, London, S.W.1, before the 4th day of March, 1955, and any such objection or representation should state the grounds on which it is made.

COUNTY OF CAMBRIDGE.

NOTICE is hereby given that in accordance with the provisions of the above-mentioned Act the Cambridgeshire County Council have now prepared the Provisional Map and Statement of alleged public footpaths and bridleways relating to the Administrative County of Cambridge, and copies thereof may be inspected at the following places:—

at The Police Station, Paddock Street, Soham.

South Cambridgeshire Rural District

at The Police Station, High Street, Melbourn.

Extracts relating to individual parishes have been placed on deposit locally, and information as to places and times for inspection may be obtained from posters which have been published locally on parish notice boards, in Post Offices, etc.

At any time within twenty-eight days from the date of this notice, the owner, lessee or occupier of any land shown on the map to which this notice relates, being land on which the map shows a public path, or a road used as a public path, may apply to Quarter Sessions for a declaration—

(a) that at the relevant date mentioned in the provisional statement there was no public right of way over the land;

(b) that the rights conferred on the public at that date by the public right of way over the land were such rights as may be specified in the application, and not such rights as are indicated in the Provisional Map and Statement;

(c) that the position or width of that part of the land over which the public right of way subsisted at the said date was as specified in the application, and not as indicated in the Provisional Map and Statement; or

(d) that the public right of way over the land at the said date was not unconditional but was

subject to limitations or conditions specified in the application, or, if the said right is indicated in the Provisional Statement as being subject to limitations or conditions, that the said right was subject to other limitations or conditions specified in the application either in addition to or in substitution for those indicated in the Provisional Statement.

A copy of the Public Rights of Way (Applications to Quarter Sessions) Regulations, 1952, is available for inspection at this office, at the Town Clerk's Office, the Guildhall, Cambridge, and at the Police Stations at Impington, Soham and Melbourn.

Any application for a declaration in respect of land situated within the City of Cambridge should be made to the Clerk of the Peace at the Guildhall, Cambridge, and for land situated within the rural area of the County, to the Clerk of the Peace at the Shire Hall, Castle Hill, Cambridge, specifying the land to which the application relates, the grounds upon which the application is made and the name of the surveying authority.

The effect of the Order will be to divert a portion of the public right of way running in a south-easterly direction from a point on the western boundary of the Ipswich Corporation Sewage Purification Works at Bobbitshole, Wherstead (Part Field O.S. 40 Suffolk (East) Sheet No. LXXXII.3 Edition 1926) for a distance of 265 feet through the said Works to a point on their south-western boundary to a line running in a southerly direction along the western boundary of the said Works for a distance of 240 feet and thence in a south-easterly direction along the south-western boundary of the said Works for a distance of 67 feet.
