NOTICE is hereby given that the Canterbury City Council, as surveying authority, have pursuant to the provisions of sections 30 and 35 of the above-mentioned Act, prepared a provisional map and statement which contains the particulars contained in the draft map and statement modified as appears requisite to the Council having regard to their determination of the objections made to the said draft map and statement.

At any time within 28 days after the publication of this notice the owner, lessee or occupier of any land shown on the map to which the notice relates being land on which the map shows a public path or a road used as a public path may dispute the correctness of the particulars contained in the provisional map and statement before the Court of Quarter Sessions in and for the City of Canterbury. Application for a declaration by the Court as to the matter or matters in dispute must be given in writing to the Clerk of the Peace, Municipal Buildings, Dane John, Canterbury, and must contain the particulars specified in the Public Rights of Way (Applications to Quarter Sessions) Regulations, 1952.
