

NATIONAL PARKS AND ACCESS TO THE COUNTRYSIDE ACT, 1949.

Brixham Urban District.

NOTICE is hereby given that the Devon County Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by subsection (3) of Section 29 of the National Parks and Access to the Countryside Act, 1949, have determined to modify the particulars contained in the draft rights of way map and statements prepared under Section 27 of the above-mentioned Act in relation to the rights of way in the Brixham Urban District within the area of the said Council as follows:—

Path No.

Modification

- 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 7 — *Add* in respect of each path the following limitations: (a) The path is held in trust for the benefit of all persons now or hereafter being inhabitants of the said Parish of Brixham or sojourning therein for the time being; (b) subject to the right of Anna Maria Maxwell Hogg her heirs and assigns to place and maintain all such gates and stiles thereon as she or they may from time to time think fit so long as persons on foot can pass through by or over the same.
- 14 *Delete* whole of path, Milton Street to Kennels Road.
- 15 *Delete* whole of path, along Mill Lane.
- 17 *Delete* whole of path, from Kingswear Road to junction with path 16 via Raddicombe.
- 19 *Delete* whole of path, Forder to Woodhuish Lane.
- 20 *Delete* whole of path, Scabbacombe Lane to beach at Scabbacombe Sands.
- 26 *Add* footpath commencing at Woodhuish Lane 240 yards north of Woodhuish Farm and proceeding northwards and westwards, then dividing and joining Mill Lane at two points north-east of Woodhuish Mill Cottages.

These paths are shown on a Map which has been deposited at the respective offices of the Clerk of the County Council at The Castle, Exeter, and the Clerk of Brixham Urban District Council, and may be seen there free of charge during the usual office hours.

Any representation or objection with respect to this determination shall be made in writing addressed to the Clerk of the County Council, The Castle, Exeter, before the 14th day of March, 1958, and shall state the grounds on which it is made.

NOTICE is hereby given that the Devon County Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by subsection (3) of section 29 of the National Parks and Access to the Countryside Act, 1949, have determined to modify the particulars contained in the draft rights of way map and statements prepared under section 27 of the above-mentioned Act in relation to the rights of way in the Paignton Urban District within the area of the said Council by the addition of a way to be shown in the draft rights of way map as a footpath commencing at Beacon Hill at the Urban District Boundary, and proceeding along a private accommodation road to Buttshill Cross and shown on a Map which has been deposited at the respective offices of the Clerk of the County Council at The Castle, Exeter, and the Clerk of the Urban District Council at Oldway, Paignton, and which may be seen there free of charge during the usual office hours.

NOTICE is hereby given that the Devon County Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by subsection (3) of section 29 of the National Parks and Access to the Countryside Act, 1949, have determined to modify the particulars contained in the draft rights of way map and statements prepared under section 27 of the above-mentioned Act in relation to the rights of way in the Borough of Totnes within the area of the said Council by the

addition of ways to be shown in the draft rights of way map as footpaths situate as follows:—

*No. on Map.**Situation.*

- 4 From Bridgetown to western end of private accommodation road known as Rowsell's Lane and along Rowsell's Lane to kissing gate.
- 9 From junction with Path No. 1 along private accommodation road south of Seymour Hotel to River Wall.
- 10 From The Plains to River Wall at Town Quay along private accommodation road adjacent to southern side of Totnes Bridge.
- 11 From The Plains to River Wall at Riding Place Quay along private accommodation road on south side of Messrs. J. Symons & Co. Ltd.'s premises.
- 12 From Shute Road along private accommodation road called New Walk to No. 8 then westwards along Quinz's or Queen's Path to Warland.
- 13 From New Walk to River Bank at Brew House Quay.
- 14 From junction of Warland and Shute Road to junction with Path 12 via Town Marsh.
- 15 From Bridgetown along private accommodation road known as Chapel Lane to junction with Path No. 4.
- 16 From New Walk to River Bank at Dye-house Quay via South side of Chapel Store.

all of which are shown on a Map which has been deposited at the respective offices of the Clerk of the County Council at The Castle, Exeter, and the Town Clerk of Totnes at Municipal Offices, Totnes, and which may be seen there free of charge during the usual office hours.
