Notice of Determination to Modify Particulars contained in the Draft Map of Public Rights of Way for North Berks

NOTICE is hereby given that the Berkshire County Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by subsection (3) of section 29 of the National Parks and Access to the Countryside Act, 1949, have determined to modify the particulars contained in the draft rights of way map and statement prepared under section 27 of the above-mentioned Act in relation to the rights of way within the northern area of the County of Berks (comprising the Boroughs of Abingdon and Wallingford, the Urban District of Wantage and the Rural Districts of Abingdon, Faringdon, Wallingford and Wantage), by the deletion of the public paths or roads used as public paths described in the First Schedule hereto, and by the addition of the public rights of way described in the Second Schedule hereto.

A map showing the effect of these modifications has been deposited and may be seen free of charge during normal office hours and on Thursdays only until 7.30 p.m. at the County Record Office, Shire Hall, Reading and at the County Branch Libraries in Abingdon, Faringdon and Wantage during the hours stated:—
