

COUNTY OF CORNWALL

Survey of Public Rights of Way

Notice is hereby given that the Cornwall County Council, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by Subsection (3) of Section 29 of the National Parks and Access to the Countryside Act, 1949, have determined to modify the particulars contained in the Draft Maps and Statements prepared under Section 27 of the above-mentioned Act in relation to the Rights of Way within the areas of the Municipal Borough of Fowey and the Urban Districts of Newquay and Padstow by:

- (1) the deletion of the paths indicated in the First Schedule hereto;
- (2) the inclusion of the paths indicated in the Second Schedule hereto;
- (3) the amendment of the paths indicated in the Third Schedule hereto.

Maps and Statements showing these modifications have been deposited at the office of the Town Clerk, Borough Offices, Fowey, at the office of the Clerk to the Council, Municipal Offices, Newquay, at the office of the Clerk to the Council, Council Offices, North Quay, Padstow, and at the office of the County Planning Officer, County Hall, Truro, where they may be inspected free of charge during normal office hours.

Any objection or representation in respect of these determinations should be made in writing and addressed to the Clerk of the County Council at the County Hall, Truro, before the 14th day of March 1959.

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URBAN DISTRICT OF THURROCK

Urban District Council of Thurrock (Footpath adjoining Wharf Road, Stanford-le-Hope) Diversion Order, 1958.

Notice is hereby given that on the 5th day of February 1959, the Minister of Housing and Local Government confirmed the above Order.

The effect of the Order will be to divert—

A length of the public right of way running from the village of Mucking to Rainbow Lane, Stanford-le-Hope commencing at a point approximately 75 feet south-west of Wharf Road and continuing in a north-easterly direction for a distance of approximately 75 feet to its junction with Wharf Road

To

A line running from the said point approximately 75 feet south-west of Wharf Road and continuing in a south-easterly direction for a distance of approximately 340 feet to join Wharf Road at a point approximately 290 feet south of its present junction with Wharf Road.

The public right of way over the new line referred to will be created on the 20th day of February 1959, that is after fourteen days have expired from the date of confirmation of the Order.

A certified copy of the Order and of the map contained in the Order has been deposited at the Thurrock Urban District Council Offices, Whitehall Lane, Grays, Essex, and will be open for inspection free of charge between the hours of 9 a.m. and 5 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays and 9 a.m. and 12 noon on Saturdays.

The Order becomes operative as from the 13th day of February 1959, but if any person aggrieved by the Order desires to question the validity thereof or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the National Parks and Access to the Countryside Act, 1949, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act or any regulation made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the approval of the Order, he may, within six weeks from the date of publication of this notice, make application to the High Court.
