The Bucks County Council and the Aylesbury Borough Council have applied to the Minister of Transport for confirmation of Orders made by them under the Road Traffic Act, 1960, the effect of which will be to impose a speed limit of 40 m.p.h. on the lengths of road set out in the Schedule below.

*Length of road in the Parishes of Stoke Mandeville—  
Weston Turville*

Aylesbury—Wendover Road, A.413, from a point approximately 200 yards south of the junction of The Marroway, B.4544 to the Aylesbury Borough Boundary.

*Length of road in the Borough of Aylesbury*

Wendover Road, A.413, from a point approximately 157 yards south-east of the junction of Spenser Road to the Aylesbury—Weston Turville—Stoke Mandeville Parish Boundary.

*Imposition of 40 m.p.h. Speed Limit at  
Stoke Mandeville*

Notice is hereby given that the Bucks County Council intend to make application to the Minister of Transport for his consent to the making of an Order, the effect of which will be that, on the following length of road, there shall be substituted a speed limit of 40 m.p.h. for the existing speed limit of 30 m.p.h.

**NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL**

*Proposed "No Waiting" Orders—Haddiscoe and  
Rollesby*

The Norfolk County Council propose to make Orders under the Road Traffic Act, 1960, the effect of which will be to prohibit the waiting of vehicles on the following lengths of road:

- (i) That length of the North Walsham—Great Yarmouth Road A.149 forming Rollesby Bridge and its approaches in the Parishes of Rollesby and Ormesby St. Michael which lies between a point 100 yards north-west of the bridge and a point 100 yards south-east of the bridge.
- (ii) That length of the Bungay—Great Yarmouth Road A.143 forming the new Haddiscoe Bridge and its approaches in the Parish of Haddiscoe which lies between a point approximately 40 yards south-west of Milestone Yarmouth 7 and a point approximately 570 yards north-eastwards.

Exceptions will be provided in the Order to enable a vehicle to wait for so long as may be necessary for

a person to board or alight from the vehicle, to enable goods to be loaded on to or unloaded from the vehicle, or to enable the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance of the road or the services therein, or as part of a funeral cortege.
