##### *Survey of Rights of Way, Provisional Map Area No. 2*

The Breconshire County Council in exercise of their duty under Part IV of the National Parks and Access to the Countryside Act, 1949, hereby give notice that, having determined and decided what modifications shall be made to the Draft Map prepared under the Act, following objections and representations under subsections (3) and (4) (b) of section 29 of the Act, they have prepared a Provisional Map under section 30 of the Act, in respect of Area No. 2 of the County of Brecon comprising the Urban Districts of Hay and Brynmawr and the Rural Districts of Hay and Crickhowell together with statements containing particulars thereof. The Provisional Map is a reproduction of the Draft Map incorporating the above-mentioned modifications.

Any owner, lessee or occupier of land over which any of the paths run, may apply to Quarter Sessions for a determination of any dispute concerning the contents of the Map and Statement. Notice of any such application should be given in writing to the Clerk of the Peace at County Hall, Brecon, within twenty-eight days after the publication of this notice, and shall specify the land to which the application relates, the grounds upon which the application is made, and the name of the surveying authority, and the applicant should serve a copy of such notice upon every other person appearing to the applicant to be the owner, lessee or occupier of the said land or of any other land specified in the application in regard to which the Court may make a declaration, and upon the Breconshire County Council as surveying authority. Applicants should consult the public rights of Way (Applications to Quarter Sessions) Regulations, 1952 (S.I. 1952 No. 559).
