Yeovil Town Map*

Notice is hereby given that proposals for alterations or additions to the above Development Plan were on the 13th day of February 1962, submitted to the Minister of Housing and Local Government for approval.

The proposals take the form of:

(1) the deletion from the Yeovil Town Map of the Trunk road notation for the A.30 road which passes through the Borough of Yeovil; and

(2) an amendment to the approved Written Statement to the effect that the construction of the proposed Inner Relief Road involves appropriating 0.55 of an acre of the public open space known as Bide's Garden.

Certified copies of the proposals as submitted have been deposited for public inspection at the Area Planning Office, 16 The Park, Yeovil, and at the Municipal Offices, Yeovil.

Copies of the proposals so deposited together with copies or relevant extracts of the Development Plan are available for inspection free of charge by all persons interested at the places mentioned above between 9.30 a.m. and 12.30 p.m. and from 2.30 p.m. to 4.30 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays inclusive.

Any objection or representation with reference to the proposals may be sent in writing to the Secretary, Ministry of Housing and Local Government, Whitehall, London, S.W.1, before the thirty-first day of March, 1962, and any such objection or representation should state the grounds on which it is made. Persons making an objection or representation may register their names and addresses with the Clerk of the County Council and will then be entitled to receive notice of any amendment of the Development Plan made as a result of the proposals.

*Modification of Particulars contained in Revised Map
and Statement as prepared in draft form*

Notice is hereby given that the County Council of the Administrative County of Middlesex in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by subsection (3) of section 29 of the National Parks and Access to the Countryside Act, 1949, have determined to modify the particulars contained in the Revised Map and Statement as prepared in draft form (hereinafter called

"the Revised Map and Statement") prepared under sections 33 and 34 of the above-mentioned Act in relation to the rights of way within the area of the said Council by:—

(a) the addition of a way to be shown in the Revised Map and Statement as a footpath Right of Way No. 48 situate at Ealing commencing at the southern bend of Wyke Gardens, thence proceeding west south-west for approximately 90 yards and then south to a bend in the River Brent; then west south-west on the south bank to the footbridge at the north end of Right of Way No. 41;

(b) the addition of a way to be shown in the Revised Map and Statement as a bridleway Right of Way No. 49 situate at Ealing and known as Clayton Road, running in a southerly direction from Ruiship Road to the Borough boundary at the commencement of Bridleway No. 13 in Hayes and Harlington;

(c) the addition of a way to be shown in the Revised Map and Statement as a footpath Right of Way No. 25, situate at Hounslow commencing on the west side of Henleys Garage on the Bath Road near the junction with the Great South-West Road and proceeding northwards to Armytage Road and Brabazon Road.

Maps indicating these determinations have been deposited at the offices of the County Planning Officer, 25 Buckingham Gate, Westminster, London S.W.1, and may be seen there free of charge between the hours of 10 a.m. and 5 p.m. on weekdays (Saturdays excepted).

Copies of such maps in so far as they relate to the Borough of Ealing and the Borough of Heston and Isleworth have also been placed on deposit at the offices of the Town Clerk, Town Hall, Ealing, London W.5, and at the offices of the Town Clerk, Town Hall, Treaty Road, Hounslow, Middlesex, respectively where they may be seen free of charge on the days and between the hours above-mentioned. Copies of the said maps have also been deposited at the following Public Libraries where they may be inspected free of charge when the Public Libraries are open to the public.

	14	<i>Add</i> bridleway from road south of Hennard Jefford eastwards over West Moor to Parish Boundary (connects with Bratton Clovelly bridleway No. 21).
	15	<i>Add</i> bridleway from road at north western corner of West Moor, south westwards to junction with bridleway No. 14 south of Hennard Jefford.
