## NATIONAL PARKS AND ACCESS TO THE COUNTRYSIDE ACT, 1949

*Survey of Public Rights of Way*

Notice is hereby given that the Cornwall County Council, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by subsection (3) of Section 29 of the National Parks and Access to the Countryside Act, 1949, have determined to modify the particulars contained in the Draft Map and Statements prepared under Section 27 of the above-mentioned Act in relation to the Rights of Way within the area of the Rural District of Camelford in the County of Cornwall by:

- (1) the deletion of the paths indicated in the First Schedule hereto;
- (2) the inclusion of the paths indicated in the Second Schedule hereto;
- (3) the amendment of the paths indicated in the Third Schedule hereto.

Maps and Statements showing these modifications have been deposited at the offices of the Clerk to the Council, Council Offices, Camelford, and at the office of the County Planning Officer, County Hall, Truro, where they may be inspected free of charge during normal office hours.

Copies of the Maps and Statements relating to each of the parishes in the Rural District are also available for inspection in those parishes by arrangement with the Parish Clerk or the Chairman of the Parish Meeting wherever appropriate.

Any objection or representation in respect of these determinations should be made in writing and addressed to the Clerk of the County Council at the County Hall, Truro, before the 16th day of December 1963.

Camelford ... ..	9	Footpath	From Parish boundary west of Trethern to road to Camelford Station.
Camelford ... ..	11	Footpath	From junction with Path 16 (St. Teath Parish) via Trethern to Hendra.
Lesnewth ... ..	3	Footpath	From Treworld via Trebiffen and Trafalgar to Path 2 north of Halamiling.
St. Teath ... ..	16	Footpath	From Lobb's Cottage southward to Parish Boundary.

St. Teath ... ..	B	Footpath	Coastal Footpath from Parish Boundary at Barretts Zawn to Parish Boundary at Treligga Common.
Tintagel ... ..	B	Footpath	From Path 48 to Benoath Beach.
Tintagel ... ..	C	Footpath	Coastal footpath from Trebarwith Strand across Treligga Common to Parish Boundary.
Trevalga ... ..	A	Footpath	From Road west of Tregaina to Road at Treweens House.
Trevalga ... ..	B	Footpath	From junction with Path A east of Tregaina via Redevalen Farm to B.3266 Road east of Redevalen.

St. Juliot ... ..	1	Footpath	From Treven Gate to Helset Wood—amended route— from Trevilla to Helset Wood: north-eastern section deleted.
St. Juliot ... ..	2	Footpath	From Trevilla to County Road near Anderton: Route amended across two fields at western end.
St. Teath ... ..	23	Footpath	From Lobb's Cottage to Treveans—amended route— northern section to road near Deli and spur to join Path 9 in Camelford Parish to be deleted.
