NATIONAL PARKS AND ACCESS TO THE COUNTRYSIDE ACT, 1949

Survey of Public Rights of Way

Notice is hereby given that the Cornwall County Council, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by sub-section (3) of Section 29 of the National Parks and Access to the Countryside Act, 1949, have determined to modify the particulars contained in the Draft Map and Statements prepared under Section 27 of the above-mentioned Act in relation to the Rights of Way within the area of the Rural District of Stratton in the County of Cornwall by:

- (1) the deletion of the path indicated in the First Schedule hereto;
- (2) the inclusion of the paths indicated in the Second Schedule hereto;
- (3) the amendment of the paths indicated in the Third Schedule hereto.

Maps and Statements showing these modifications have been deposited at the offices of the Clerk to the Stratton Rural District Council, Council Offices, 17 The Strand, Bude, and at the office of the County Planning Officer, County Hall, Truro, where they may be inspected free of charge during normal office hours.

Copies of the Maps and Statements relating to each of the parishes in the Rural District are also available for inspection in those parishes by arrangement with the Parish Clerk or the Chairman of the Parish Meeting wherever appropriate.

Any objection or representation in respect of these determinations should be made in writing and addressed to the Clerk of the County Council at the County Hall, Truro, before the 6th day of January 1964.

St. Gennys ...	C	Footpath	From Coastal Path across O.S. Nos. 534, 535 and 536 to Voter Beach and High Cliff.
St. Gennys ...	E	Footpath	(Butterfly Lane) from Gillards Moor on A.39 road to Kingsleigh.
St. Gennys ...	F	Footpath	From Old Engine House, Trelay Bungalow to the Rosecare-Wainhouse Corner Road, half a mile south-west of Wainhouse Corner.
St. Gennys ...	G	Footpath	From Catchgate to the Tremayna Farm Road.
St. Gennys ...	H	Footpath	(Butterfly Valley) from Higher Dizzard to the coastal path north of Chipman Point.
St. Gennys ...	I	Footpath	From Trengayor Farm to "Atlantic View" via Landy Wood.
St. Gennys ...	J	Footpath	Coastal footpath from Parish boundary at Canceave Strand to junction with Path 2 north of Crackington Haven and from junction with Path 10 at Cambreak to Parish boundary at Rusey Cliff.
St. Gennys ...	K	Footpath	From Crackington Haven-Tresparrrett Posts Road across footbridge near car park to Crackington Haven-Wainhouse Corner Road with a spur from the footbridge to road at north-east side of Crackington Haven Bridge.

Morwenstow ...	3	Footpath	From Woodford to Tonacombe Gate: Amended route—section north of Path 10 to road east of Stanbury Cross to be deleted.
Poundstock ...	11	Footpath	From Lion's Den via Trebarfoote Coombe to Millook: Amended route—extended to County Road at Millook.
Poundstock ...	7	Footpath	From Mill Farm to Penhalt Lane: Amended route—extended to join Path 11.
Poundstock ...	14	Footpath	From Lion's Den via Trebarfoote Manor to Millook: Amended route—extended to join Path 11.
St. Gennys ...	18	Footpath	From Pengold to Trevigue Ford: Amended route—extended to join Path 20 near Trevigue Cottage and southwards to join Path 19 at Pengold.
St. Gennys ...	17	Footpath	From road north of Bayparks via Trehole to Trevigue: Amended route to make path continuous at Trehole and Trevigue Farms.
Week St. Mary ...	4	Footpath	From Quarry Lane to Odd Mill: Amended route—extended from Odd Mill to join Path 9 in Whitstone Parish.
Whitstone...	9	Bridleway	Amended status—Footpath.
