Any objection to the Order must be made in writing, stating the grounds of the objection, and addressed to the Secretary, Ministry of Housing and Local Government, Whitehall, London S.W.1, before the 14th day of October 1963.

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## COUNTY OF LINCOLN—PARTS OF LINDSEY

*Survey of Rights of Way*
