Quethiock ... ..	4	Footpath.	From Quethiock Village to Lambest footbridge on Parish boundary.
Quethiock ... ..	6	Footpath.	From Trehunist Village to Coombe Farm.
Quethiock ... ..	7	Footpath.	From the Trehunist—Tilland Road via Clemoses to Lucoombe Farm (except the length which coincides with Path 10).
Quethiock ... ..	13	Footpath.	Southern section between Lucoombe Farm and junction with Path 11.
Quethiock ... ..	14	Footpath.	From road near St. Petroc's Church at Blunts across fields to junction with Path 13 at Lucoombe Farm.
St. Dominick ... ..	5	Footpath.	From County Road at Bohetherick Wood across woodland to foreshore and on to raised sea defence works thence via Greenbank and Chapel Farm over foreshore to County Road at Halton Quay.
St. Dominick ... ..	6	Footpath.	From County Road at Dairymill Farm northwards past Old Quarry to County Road north of Burcombe.
St. Germans ... ..	7	Footpath.	From Cutcrew Farm, Tideford, across fields to Tideford Cross Lane at Lanthorne Road entrance.
St. Germans ... ..	8	Footpath.	From field south of Molenick Lane across field to Molenick Lane and across further fields past Molenick Farm to road east of farm.
St. Germans ... ..	10	Footpath.	From Mount Pleasant, Cutmere Lane, across fields, between Dennybowe Quarry and Challicotts Quarry across stream to Cutcrew Sawmills.
St. Germans ... ..	11	Footpath.	From Cutcrew Sawmills through Harsdon Coppice and across fields to join Path 19 west of the Tideford Cross—Tideford road.
St. Germans ... ..	12	Footpath.	From road south-east of Padderbury at edge of fields to Trequite.
St. Germans ... ..	13	Footpath.	From road at Heskyn east of Challicotts Wood, north of Ruffy Plantation, through Cutmere and Griffle, across fields through Berry to road at Furze Park.
St. Germans ... ..	17	Footpath.	From Cutcrew Farm, Tideford, across fields to Little Cutcrew road near Little Cutcrew with a spur rejoining Cutcrew Lane north of Cutcrew Farm.
St. Germans ... ..	19	Footpath.	From Heskyn Bridge at edge of fields via Treduan to the Tideford Cross—Tideford road at Tideford Cross Lane.
St. Germans ... ..	29	Footpath.	From bend of County Road at Cot Marine Corner down cliff to Bass Rock.
St. Germans ... ..	31	Footpath.	From County Road at Downderry through Broad's Yard past Reservoir and via Lower Deviock Farm to road near Treireife Farm.
St. Germans ... ..	32	Footpath.	From Barahead across fields and under railway to junction with Path 13 east of Berry.
St. Germans ... ..	37	Footpath.	From Darby Lane, Tideford, across one field to Molenick.
St. Germans ... ..	38	Footpath.	From road at Molenick Corner, Tideford at edge of fields to Kilquite.
St. Germans ... ..	39	Footpath.	From road at Molenick Farm, Tideford across fields to Tideford Cross Roads.
St. Germans ... ..	40	Footpath.	From Molenick Lane South of Molenick Farm at edge of fields to Cutcrew Lane north of Cutcrew Farm, Tideford.
Sheviock ... ..	8	Footpath.	Section from main A.38 road near Sconner Farm across fields to Sconner Limekiln at edge of Saltings.

## SECOND SCHEDULE

Parish	Path No.	Status	Description
Calstock ... ..	A	Footpath.	By steps from Fore Street (opposite National Provincial Bank) westwards past Baptist Chapel to rejoin Fore Street and Sand Lane: known as Baptist Lane, Calstock.
Calstock ... ..	B(I)	Footpath.	By steps from Fore Street northwards to Providence Place (Willow House) thence eastwards to rejoin Fore Street, Calstock.
Calstock ... ..	D	Footpath.	By steps from Fore Street southwards to road at Quay: known as Tamar Place, Calstock.
Calstock ... ..	F(II)	Footpath.	From Fore Street, Calstock, at rear of the Boot Inn in a southerly direction for a distance of approximately 100 ft. to junction with County Road.
Calstock ... ..	F(III)	Footpath.	From County Road in a westerly direction to Calstock Post Office and Quay.
Calstock ... ..	G	Footpath.	From Sand Lane (Fore Street) by Valley Forge Cafe to Quay near Ferry (i.e. the most easterly of the two ways leading from Sand Lane to the Ferry), Calstock.
