NATIONAL COAL BOARD

THE OPENCAST COAL ACT, 1958

Notice is hereby given that the Minister of Power, in exercise of the power conferred upon him by section 1 of the Opencast Coal Act, 1958, granted on the 10th day of December 1965, to the National Coal Board an authorisation entitled The Snyderdale Site Authorisation 1965, to work coal by opencast operations or cause or permit coal to be worked by opencast operations.

The land comprised in the authorisation is described in the Schedule hereto.

A copy of the authorisation and of the map referred to therein can be inspected at the offices of the National Coal Board, Opencast Executive, Bowers Row Area Office, Woodlesford, Leeds, between the hours of 10 a.m. and 4 p.m. on weekdays Monday to Friday inclusive.

The authorisation becomes operative on the date on which this notice is first published in a local newspaper, or the date on which it is first published in the *London Gazette*, whichever is the later date, but if any person aggrieved by the authorisation desires to question the validity thereof, or of any provision contained therein, on the ground that the authorisation is not empowered to be granted under the above-mentioned Act, or desires to question the validity thereof on the ground that any requirement of that Act or of any regulation made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the authorisation, he may within six weeks from the date on which the authorisation becomes operative make application to the High Court under paragraph 15 of the First Schedule to the Acquisition of Land (Authorisation Procedure) Act, 1946, as applied by paragraph 9 of the First Schedule to the Opencast Coal Act, 1958.

BELPER RURAL DISTRICT COUNCIL

Belper Rural District (Oakerthorpe) Public Path Creation Order, 1965

Notice is hereby given that on the 7th day of December 1965, the Minister of Housing and Local Government confirmed the above Order.

Its effect is to create a footpath starting at point "A" on the map 3 yards south-west of a point on the south side of Bunkers Hill, Oakerthorpe, approximately 140 yards from the junction of the said Bunkers Hill with Chesterfield Road, Oakerthorpe, and running west, north-west for a distance of 64 yards to point "B" on the map at the path's junction with a footpath running from South Wingfield Railway Station to Bunkers Hill, Oakerthorpe.
