

Copies of the Definitive Map and Statement have been deposited at the office of the County Planning Officer, County Hall, Truro, and at the offices of the Clerk of the Rural District Council, 20 Western Road, Launceston, where they may be inspected free of charge during normal office hours. Copies of the Maps and Statements relating to each of the Parishes in the Rural District are also available for inspection in those Parishes by arrangement with the Clerk of the Parish Council or with the Chairman of the Parish Meeting where there is no Parish Council.

Any person desiring to question the validity of the Definitive Map on the ground that the Map is not

within the powers of the Act or on the ground that any requirement of the Act or of any regulation made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the preparation of the Map or of any draft or provisional map on which that Map is based, may within 6 weeks after the date of publication of this notice make an application to the High Court in accordance with the provisions of Part. III of the First Schedule to the Act.

Subject thereto, the second Revised Map and Statement in Definitive Form become operative on the date of the publication of this notice.
