*Cramlington Comprehensive Development Area Amendment and Extension*

Notice is hereby given that on the 31st day of March 1967 the Minister of Housing and Local Government amended the above Development Plan.

The amendment becomes operative as from the 5th day of April 1967, but if any person aggrieved by it desires to question the validity thereof or of any provision contained therein on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Town and Country Planning Act, 1962, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act or any regulation made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the making of the amendment, he may, within six weeks from the 5th day of April 1967, make application to the High Court.

The proposals dealt with in the amendment consist of an amendment and extension to the Cramlington Comprehensive Development Area and involve the addition to the Comprehensive Development Area of approximately 390 acres of land at its north-west boundary within the rural district of Castle Ward and the designation for compulsory acquisition of an area of approximately 170 acres of the said land on the west side of the Newcastle—Bedlington Road A.1068 and on the north of the Newcastle—Edinburgh railway line, 150 acres of this being allocated for industrial use and the remaining 20 acres for woodlands.
